الضوابط العامة للورقة الامتحانية لمادة اللغة الانجليزية:

- أن تكون أسئلة الورقة الإمتحانية في حدود المقرر الدراسي المستهدف.
- أن تتوزع الأسئلة على نواتج التعلم للمادة وفق الوزن النسبي لها.
- أن تغطي الأسئلة مستويات الصعوبة المختلفة لتكون قادرة على التمييز بين مستويات التحصيل الدراسي للطلاب.
- أن تتدرج الأسئلة في الورقة الامتحانية من الأسهل إلى الأصعب.
- أن توازن الورقة الامتحانية بين المستويات المعرفية المختلفة.
- أن تكون الأسئلة محددة وواضحة في صياغتها اللغوية.
- أن تستوفي الورقة الامتحانية البيانات الأساسية (المرحلة - الصف - المادة - الزمن - الدرجة - الفصل الدراسي لغير الثانوية العامة - العام الدراسي).
- جودة تنسيق الورقة الامتحانية بما يضمن مقروئيتها؛ حجم الخط - نوع الخط - المسافات بين السطور والهوامش - العناوين - تعليمات الأسئلة - جودة الطباعة - الخلو من الاخطاء اللغوية والطباعة.
- يراعى في أسئلة الورقة الامتحانية عدم احتواءها على اية موضوعات أو عبارات سياسية أو دينية أو منحازة الى فئة معينة عنه دون غيرها.
- بالنسبة لسؤال قطعة الفهم القرائي لابد أن تحتوي القطعة في معظمها على مفردات لغوية مما درسه الطالب على أن لا يتم إدراج القطعة من كتب المقرر الدراسي للصف المستهدف.

These questions should test the following reading comprehension skills: extracting information, skimming, scanning and understanding reference.

5- Write a paragraph of ONE HUNDRED (100) words on Only ONE of the following topics: (8 marks)

Two (2) topics are provided. Students are asked to write a paragraph of ONE HUNDRED (100) words on ONE of the topics given.

Three (3) marks for grammar and vocabulary, Two (2) marks for coherence and cohesion, and Three (3) marks for punctuation and spelling.

A- Comment on Only TWO (2) of the following quotations: (4 Marks)

Students are given THREE quotations. They are asked to comment on TWO quotations only. (Two marks each)

B- Answer only THREE (3) of the following questions: (6 Marks)

FOUR (4) questions are given. Students are asked to answer Three (3) only. These questions should deal with the theme, the character, and the students' critical thinking skill. (Two marks each)

Students are asked to answer Two (2) questions on the poem(s) studied during the term. These questions should be about paraphrasing and (rhyme scheme or figures of speech). (Two marks each)

TWO topics are provided. Students are asked to write a paragraph of ONE HUNDRED and TEN (110) words on ONE of the topics given.

Three (3) marks for grammar and vocabulary, Two (2) marks for coherence and cohesion, and Three (3) marks for punctuation and spelling.

These questions should test the following reading comprehension skills:

***Extracting information * Skimming *Scanning* Understanding reference, Critical thinking and Word recognition**

D- Writing (8 Marks)

5- Write a paragraph of ONE HUNDRED and TWENTY (120) words on Only ONE of the following topics:

TWO (2) topics are provided. Students are asked to write a paragraph of ONE HUNDRED and TWENTY (120) words on **One** of the topics given.

Three (3) marks for vocabulary and structure, Three (3) marks for coherence and cohesion, and Two (2) marks for punctuation and spelling).

E- Literature (13 Marks)

6-The Novel: (10 Marks)

6-A Comment on TWO (2) only of the following quotations: (4 Marks)

THREE (3) quotations are given. Students are asked to comment on TWO only. (2 marks each)

B. Answer THREE (3) only of the following questions: (6 Marks)

FOUR questions are given. Students are asked to answer **THREE** questions only dealing with characters, events, themes, symbolism, etc. (2 marks each)
